



## Application for membership



Ceramic artists/craftspeople who live or work in County Cork, and who are primarily concerned with working in ceramics, may apply for membership of the Society of Cork Potters.

Members can take part in Exhibitions, Workshops, Meetings and other events organised by the Society. Where the Society opens events to non-members, paid-up Members will have priority and will be able to take part at reduced rates.

Members are entitled to a page in the web site [www.corkpotters.com](http://www.corkpotters.com) containing images and text, upon payment of a once-off set-up fee of €20.

Members are expected to attend meetings whenever possible and to actively participate in the organisation and administrative tasks of the group.

The annual membership fee covers the 12 months running from mid-March to mid-March, and must be paid before a member is permitted to vote at the A.G.M.

Members who do not pay their subscription on time will lose their entitlement to a member's web page, and the page will be taken down. Reinstatement of the page will incur a further €20 set-up fee.

The Society reserves the right to refuse membership, at the discretion of the membership committee. In this case, any fees paid will be refunded.
